- 1. I recommend improving the title to reflect the purpose of this article.
- 2. In the abstract, it is stated that the sample was "purposefully and randomly chosen," which is not true. Is it a purposive sample or a random sample?
- 3. From examining the purpose of the study, it is noted that the study methodology is invalid. I recommend that the study approach be a qualitative research design to achieve the study objectives. The descriptive survey design is not useful in this regard. In addition, the written hypotheses do not reflect the research question. Please reconsider.
- 4. The results of the study need to be reconsidered. The descriptive data do not support the results of the study.
