Review of: "The Psychology of Crowd Behaviour"

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The manuscript is well-written and does a great job of introducing the social identity approach as it applies to crowd behavior, and then describing recent advances in our understanding of both topics. The only feedback I'd provide is regarding the manuscript's length and level of integration. The manuscript might read better as a shorter synthesis of the section topics covered, or as three longer, section-topic-focused manuscripts or book chapters.
