Lissencephaly with cerebellar hypoplasia type D (LCHd) is a form of lissencephaly with cerebellar hypoplasia characterized by pronounced microcephaly (at least  $\pm 3$  SD), intellectual disability, spastic diplegia and moderate to severe cerebellar hypoplasia involving both vermis and hemispheres.
