The writing is well organized, and the details discussed are well justified.

Some secondary modifications to attend to:

- 1) The presentation is very good, but its objectives of incorporating LLMs in STEM graduation must be justified; for example, the learning difficulty required by the use of this technology.
- 2) Excessive use of long phrases and their symbols such as "natural language processing (NLP)", on lines 27, 58, Large Language Models (LLMs) on lines 39, 170, abstract.
- 3) There are redundant texts, for example, in section 5 and some lines of 5.1.
