Based on the realistic analysis of China's situation, the article puts forward and verifies the hypothesis, which has certain realistic pertinence and theoretical contribution. But after reading the article, I have some questions that the author needs to answer or think further:

- 1. Whether there is more systematic and in-depth specific theoretical support behind the constructed analytical framework, rather than just scattered literature support, or whether the criteria for such division are scientific or comprehensive;
- 2. In the "CPC's attitude to private capital" section of the article, it is necessary to specify how to assign values and collect and process data;
- 3. The conclusion part is too few. Compared with the previous part, this part needs to be supplemented with more in-depth policy recommendations;
- 4. There are too few references other than Chinese, and the proportion of online documents is too large. It is suggested to ensure the authority of the source of online documents.

If these problems are solved, this paper will have a better improvement in terms of standardization and theoretical depth.
