1. How many researchers carried out the coding? how to guarantee the validity of the data, for example, by explaining the data triangulation method used.
2. Inclusion and exclusion criteria as a continuation of the purposive sampling method have not been explicitly explained.
3. The research limitations include the limited number of samples; this is not in accordance with the principles of qualitative research, which is not oriented towards sample size but the depth of the data.
