'Endless search for medicinal plants' instead of 'endless search for food'.

'This hallucinogenic come usually from plant substances or derivatives, although they occur in many plants and animals'- The word 'animals' can be deleted; the paragraph can focus only on plants.

The history section 2.2 can be moved to introduction.

Overall, the arrangement of the text can be improved. The abstract mentions two plants, but in the text, other plants were elaborated as well. The materials and methods can be improved and clearly written.
