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This paper presents a hypothesis concerning the cause of lunate osteonecrosis.

The paper is concise, well-written, and contains logical arguments from anatomical and physiological points of view.

Clinical or experimental data to support the hypothesis are missing, but this is not the purpose of the paper.

The listed references are adequate and sufficient.

Consequently, the hypothesis is very plausible, the conclusions are logical, and the suggestion to the clinician to drain the post-trauma hematoma as early as possible is logical.

I recommend this paper for publication in its present version!
