The therapeutic strategy based on EECP holds promise for future research in the field of HF, both with reduced and preserved ejection fraction. However, there are currently no studies to be reviewed on the use of this technology in HFPEF. Only one trial has been published so far with patients with HFREF. Nonetheless, the authors should be congratulated for provoking this topic, but I feel it is premature to suggest this can be the object of a review article. I would suggest a "point of view" or "perspective" type of manuscript, as more appropriate to the current status of research in the field.

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
