The paper proposes an in-depth analysis of the literature review on economic processes related to the secondary sector, detailing the main changes in industrial organisation from industrial districts and clusters to circular innovation ecosystems. The paper is well done: the aim of the paper is clear; the methodology, mainly consisting of a selection of studies from the main academic databases (such as Scopus or Google Scholar), is adequately described; the results are clearly presented, also making several tables to better explain the main significant outcomes; the conclusions are well supported by the results.
