The article is extremely interesting and enhances understanding of global AI governance. It fills the gap in the field where the Western tradition is dominating the research. The research question is clear, and the study answers it with a well-described methodology. I would suggest that the writer should still re-check the article, since there seem to be some obscurities. For instance, in 5.1.2, the last paragraph starts to explain Latin America, although the chapter is about Kenya. The 6.1 title is also missing. I would also suggest that it would be good to structure the key findings into a table format. This is, however, dependent on the preferences one has, but my opinion is that a table format would be good. With these improvements, I suggest the article could be published, and it will be valuable for the scientific community.
