- A theoretical foundation would enhance the article's overall structure and improve the research's coherence.

Data Analysis and Visualization:

- Enhance the data analysis section by incorporating statistical evidence, charts, or graphs to support key findings.
- Visual representations can strengthen the study's credibility and provide a clearer understanding of the research outcomes.

In-depth Analysis of Results and Discussion:

• Provide a more in-depth data analysis in the results and discussion sections.



 Expanding on the findings with additional insights and interpretations would enrich the content and contribute to a more comprehensive understanding.

Limitations and Methodological Biases:

- Explicitly discuss the limitations and potential biases in the research methodology.
- Acknowledging these aspects will add transparency to the study and help readers interpret the results more critically.

Specificity in Recommendations:

- Make the proposed solutions more specific and actionable.
- Concrete examples or case studies of successful adaptation strategies would strengthen the practical utility of the article and guide potential interventions.

Concluding Remarks:

- Summarize the key takeaways and contributions of the study more succinctly in the concluding remarks.
- A clear and concise conclusion will leave a lasting impression on the reader and emphasize the significance of the research.

Overall Organization:

- Ensure a logical flow in the article's organization, with each section seamlessly leading to the next.
- A well-structured article enhances readability and facilitates a smooth transition between different aspects of the research.

Language and Style:

- Ensure consistency in language and style throughout the article.
- A consistent writing style contributes to the research's professional presentation and enhances the manuscript's overall
 quality.

This article could be acceptable with some major improvements starting from framing the model, including some literatures in the introduction, proper explanation of data analysis, better interpretation of results and discussion, and specificity in relevant recommendations.
