

Review of: "A Review of the Processes and Procedures of Road Traffic Accident Mortality Data Collection in Zambia"

Although this work has virtues, it is not important enough to be published in a peer-reviewed journal. It is more of a data sources discussion paper. It may be suitable for conference proceedings, but there isn't much new science in it to make it worth publishing. Most of the material in it is already well-known to practitioners and researchers.

The paper has some repetition, which makes sections of it difficult to read. For instance, the first paragraph on page 5 and the second paragraph beneath the section 2 header of the literature review. Another issue is that questionnaires and interviews were conducted without ethics permission, or at the very least, no mention of privacy concerns was made. Some sample analysis of data from one or two sources might improve the paper.
