A comprehensive literature review is essential to provide a solid foundation for the research and support the claims made throughout the article.

The findings and results section lacks a robust data analysis. While descriptive statistics are provided, a detailed discussion and interpretation of the results are missing. The article fails to include inferential statistical analyses or significance testing, making it challenging to draw meaningful conclusions from the data presented. Comprehensive data analysis is crucial for supporting the study's findings and contributing to the knowledge base in the field.
