Still there are restrictions in framing the rules for residential buildings. But in the case of fire accidents the loss of life and properties are high in commercial and residential zone.

The authors can suggest the suitable and simple remedies with classification of zones for better implementations. The same can be achievable with better implementation by framing byelaws.

Regular and periodical visits by concern fire safety department to the zones can be a better prevention measure.

However, more stringent rules to be framed in terms of planning low cost/small scale/apartment and other housing systems in the beginning of construction stage itself. The author can throw some light on this based on architectural point of view.

When it comes to implementation/inspection, a proper well documented policy is needed
