

Review of: "Exploring the Role of Social, Economic, and Cultural Factors in Community Development: A Social Work Perspective in T/A Chimwala, Mangochi"

Abstract: The abstract is written well but try to make it succinct.

Introduction: The introduction is well written

Literature review: There should be a literature review section on community development and its relevance to social work. It is also necessary to add another theoretical background section to discuss the Strengths-Based Perspective and its relevance to the topic/title.

Methodology: This section is not clear. The methods used should be explained in detail giving reasons why they were preferred. The actual sampling methods used should be identified and explained rather than just stating that probability and non probability methods were used. Finally the total number of the respondents must be stated.

Data analysis: the interviewee profile should be included here. Some key points and relevant arguments are presented in this section. However, they lack depth and reference from theoretical frameworks to support them. Although this has been done with some, having a theoretical framework section under literature review as recommended earlier may assist in developing this section.
