However, if additional revisions are needed, I suggest that at the end of the introduction paragraph, apart from mentioning the research gap, the author should also explain the rationale and urgency of the research, write a research question, and the objectives of the research.

In the literature review, each sub-heading section after providing quotes from experts, the author also needs to provide conclusions regarding the relationship between the theory and the author's research.

It's better when you quote not just one in each sentence. But it can be supported by a few quotes.

The results and discussion are sufficient to provide answers to the objectives of your research.
