The author of "Redefining borders in the contested territory between San Pedro and San Andres Cholula" provides an interesting and comprehensive understanding of the redefinition of borders between two of the municipalities of the Metropolitan Area of Puebla in Mexico. The author draws attention to the ethnic differences in population structure and the territorial disputes that have played a significant role in defining political borders between different communities. A more detailed discussion of this topic could offer valuable insights into the study of territorial borders and their redefinition.

Regarding cartography

It is imperative that all maps presented in the article include the option of increased scale (zoom) visualization and high spatial resolution, as well as orientation for a proper understanding of cartography.

Figure 1 must be accompanied by an individual legend for each of the maps to explain its contents.

Figures 2 and 3 must have a legend, scale, and symbol for orientation in the plate. While a single scale bar could be introduced as all the maps are depicted in the same scale, it is non-negotiable that each map has its own legend.

Figure 4 must have a legend, symbol for orientation and scale to be properly understood.

Figure 6 must include both scale and orientation for proper context.
