Your paper initially needs language editing. Please revise the paper on the type of tense you should use in the abstract, result discussion and the introduction section.

For example

Usually you should not use the present tense in the "This research delves into the intriguing relationship between learning behaviors and academic performance among students."

In the paper the major goal is to deal with the "Relationship between learning behaviors and academic performance among students". Please clarify what type of learning behaviors you are dealing with. Furnish your work in the literature review and the introduction section with the theoretical underpinning then in the discussion support or reject the findings of the previous work done.

"The study identifies three primary categories of learners: active learners, characterized by their enthusiastic participation and initiative; passive learners, marked by their reserved behaviors; and self-directed learners..." is vague. It is not clear how did you identify the categories.
