If taking survey as a key tool for the study, there should be sufficient sample strength to support the study. Also the survey has to be correlated to the architectural/ built environment parameters so as to understand, whether cpted has a role in the study or not. No architectural layouts or plans of the cmapuses were studied or dealt with in the study.

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
