The subject and title of the article are quite interesting. When the content is examined, it is seen that the subject is addressed in an extremely limited manner. My review results are below;

1. First of all, it should be clearly stated why these two countries are being compared,
2. Although the brief summary section is longer than necessary, the Introduction section is insufficient. It should be strengthened with literature support. Especially for Sweden and India, physical and human information should be provided using statistical sources.
3. Studies carried out by research areas on climate change should be presented in numerical expressions.
4. The comparison method of both countries should be written clearly. For Example By performing a SWOT analysis, the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats of both countries in adaptation to climate change can be revealed analytically. This method will strengthen the work.
5. As a result of the analysis, solution suggestions should be evaluated and given separately for each item. It is quite limited in this form. It should be more detailed and integrated.
6. In conclusion; The article is quite good in terms of idea and use of language. However, in my opinion, the treatment of the subject is not suitable for the structure of an academic article. It gives the impression of a preliminary preparation of an academic article or its promotion in the media. If it is developed, it will be a very interesting and valuable article.
