

Review of: "Ayurveda & Bioactives as Adjuvant for Dna Modulation in Cancer Treatment & Adverse Drug Reaction [ADR] – A Glimpse of Traditional Indian Nanotechnology"

In its current state, the manuscript is not fit for publication. The following points need to be addressed:

1. The title is too complex and needs simplification.
2. Abstract contains a spelling error (Occimum instead of Ocimum)
3. There are several grammatical errors in the manuscript, and the manuscript needs to be polished significantly. The manuscript is written in "layman" terms and not in a scientific sense.
4. Abstract needs polishing. The significance/purpose of the review needs to be highlighted in the abstract. Whether this paper is a research/review paper also needs to be mentioned clearly in the abstract.
5. Statistics are provided for the year 2018. It would be best to have more recent data.
6. Details on the mechanism of action besides a one-liner need to be provided.
7. The title of the paper mentions "nanotechnology," yet I do not see any subheading addressing nanotechnology. I only see the Ayurveda perspective, but the relationship between Ayurveda and nanotechnology is not present in the paper.
8. There is no continuous flow in the paper. I was not sure of the objective of the paper—what is the paper trying to say? Words like DNA modulation, Ayurveda, nanotechnology are mentioned, but there is no interconnection. Reading the paper also makes me lose focus on the objective of the paper.

I think it is necessary to highlight the purpose/objective of the paper and work towards it. There are several key words that are clubbed together, but there is no explanation as to why. Structures of some key ingredients need to be provided to improve the paper.
