Secondly, while the text mentions the adoption of AIS and the influence of interface design, a more explicit statement about the existing gap in knowledge or what this study contributes to the field would enhance clarity.

Thirdly, it would be helpful to explicitly state the objectives of the study. This will help readers anticipate the outcomes and understand the specific goals of the research.

Fourthly, some citations lack clarity due to variations in styles (e.g., et al., 2021; Gunawan et al., 2018; Szymkowiak et al., 2021). Using a consistent citation style will enhance readability.

Fifthly, some sections could benefit from smoother transitions between ideas. For example, between the discussion on AIS, user acceptance, and interface design.

Lastly, while TAM theory is mentioned, providing a brief explanation or context about TAM (Technology Acceptance Model) would be helpful for readers unfamiliar with the term.

Addressing these points will contribute to a clearer and more reader-friendly text.
