

Review of: "Women's misogyny in modern culture, with a mythological allusion to Draupadi"

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In the article, Satpathy (2022) argued a serious issue, gender inequality, that remained in society, which made women often face oppressive conditions and barriers. However, it would be better if the author could introduce Draupadi's story early for readers who are not familiar with the character and the story, and the readers could better understand the purpose of the article and how the character is related to feminist studies. However, I think it would be better if the author could provide further reflections and implications on what we could do or learn from the story to empower women and decrease gender inequality in society. For instance, in the conclusion, the author mentioned "they provide women the power to rebel against the epic's and society's patriarchal, ... these texts become testaments to their resistance and battle to discover their voice and a platform to communicate it." However, as a reader, I would like to learn more about how this is achieved and how does this epic make a realistic impact on women's life in the real world.
