A test that measures a person's average *blood glucose level* over the past 2 to 3 months. Hemoglobin is the part of a red blood cell that carries oxygen to the cells and sometimes joins with the *glucose* in the bloodstream. Also called *hemoglobin A1C* or *glycosylated hemoglobin*, the test shows the amount of glucose that sticks to the red blood cell, which is proportional to the amount of glucose in the blood. Results are given as a percentage or as an average glucose value, called an *estimated average glucose*.
