

Review of: "Outcomes of Rezum Water Vapor Therapy for Benign Prostate Obstruction with One-Year Follow-Up: Largest Real-World Data from Türkiye"

This is an interesting and well-written manuscript about the efficacy and safety of Rezum treatment for benign prostate obstruction.

However, there is a space for some improvements.

- For example, in the description of the Thermal Treatment Procedure, there is unnecessary duplication of a part of the text ("...through a retractable needle, with saline flush irrigation used to enhance visualization and cool the urethra.")
- The rate of complications seems not to be neglectable, so it would be good to discuss complications from this study with other Rezum trials (and others like TUR-P). (Note: "neglectable" is an unusual word; consider revising for clarity.)
- There are Tables and Figures mentioned in the text, but I wasn't able to find them (neither on the web preprint nor in the PDF version). Showing Tables and Figures would surely contribute to the clarity of the manuscript.
