Liquid, usually multidose preparation consisting of a suspension intended for oral use. The preparation is administered in small volumes by means of a suitable measuring device such as a dropper, pipette or oral syringe capable of accurate dosing of the suspension. The measured dose may be diluted in water or another suitable liquid before swallowing.
