For the antidiabetic, antihelmintic, antihyperlipidemic, hepatoprotective and memory enhancing activities, there were no speculated relationships shown between the phytoconstituents and the pharmacological effect of the plant. Therefore, the authors should properly attempt to link all pharmacological activities listed to the phytoconstituents in the plant. Since the phytochemical profile of the plant has been extensively studied as well as some compounds isolated from the plant. The attempt of linking these constituents to the pharmacological activities of the plant is possible since most of these constituents have been individually investigated for their pharmacological activities.
