 - Any resection done(remove parts)?how long and which part of the histology taken?
 - Any extra complimentary investigation taken for Crohn's disease diagnosis?
 - What will be surveillance plan for patient?
- Discussion: too brief discussion and not highlight point learned from this case
- Conclusion: Need to redo and revision
- Reference: from 2002 to 2022, relevant and recent
- Figures: good quality. Need to state in main text.
