

Review of: "Analysis of Renewable Energy Deployment and Investment for Rural Health Facility Electrification: A Case Study of Kenya, Ghana, and Rwanda"

This study presents a quite thorough analysis regarding the effect of renewable energy deployment on improving health facilities, leading to better statistics regarding - among also other parameters - mortality rates. The study is interesting and promising for future work, but there are some key points that must be addressed:

1. The year reference is 2019: I would expect the authors to mention at least "forecasting" for the current status (2024 - 5 years later).
2. The methodology that was followed is not so clear in terms of taking into account specific parameters (and maybe with specific weights). I would suggest the authors emphasize and focus on the "why" these parameters were selected and, moreover, give a detailed explanation about the correlations between the effect of these parameters on the final results and conclusions.
