The article provided an intriguing overview of Tonle Sap Lake and its interdisciplinary connections. The author has compiled information spanning a considerable time frame up to the present. However, the information lacks thorough analysis and interpretation from a political ecology perspective. The conditions are presented at face value without the author's analytical synthesis of the results. Moreover, the paper resembles a report more than a scientific article. It lacks focus on objectives, methods, and results, with lengthy paragraphs delving into excessive details at times and insufficient coverage of important issues. Additionally, there is an unnecessary abundance of abbreviations. Further comments are highlighted throughout the paper (attached file).
