The technical content of the paper is good enough. Research is clear and well-balanced but it should be improved before publication in some points:

- 1. Reviewer does not like acronyms used in the Abstract. Abstract should be as much readable as possible. I suggest to move the acronyms (such as SANDF and SAAF) in the main body of the paper at the point they first appear.
- 2. In the title of the paper why using "(South Africa)" and not simply "Waterkloof in South Africa".
- 3. Authors say "An aerodrome is a stimulus to society from the standpoint of economic growth and the services it offers to the public." This is true and is a key point. May I suggest to add some new references on the topic: DOI 10.15632/jtam-pl/119017 and doi: 10.1007/s11069-017-3072-3
- 4. Is it really needed a point mark "What is an airbase?" Please think to a new title.
- 5. Can the authors improve quality of Figure 1 ??
