- 3. The introduction section has not used any theoretical lens to develop and design the research questions.
- 4. Each of the hypotheses should be discussed in detail.
- 5. There is no conclusion, limitations, or future scope of the study section.

- 1. Relationship to Literature: Does the paper demonstrate an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and cite an appropriate range of literature sources?
- 2. Results: Are results presented clearly and analysed appropriately? Do the conclusions adequately tie together the other elements of the paper?
- 3. Implications for research, practice and/or society: Does the paper clearly identify any implications for research, practice and/or society? Does the paper bridge the gap between theory and practice? How can the research be used in practice (economic and commercial impact), in teaching, to influence public policy, in research (contributing to the body of knowledge)? What is the impact upon society (influencing public attitudes, affecting quality of life)?
