The authors provide an adequate consideration in the introduction, outlining the economic environment in Greece, particularly focusing on the recovery after the recession and the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic. In this regard, more detail on the discussion of specific gaps in the existing literature would be welcome.

The methodology used is coherent with the study; however, additional details regarding the selection of the years studied and the variations in regional data would enhance clarity in its explanation. Results are clearly shown by tables, images, and graphs. Nevertheless, a reasonable discussion on the reasons for regional variations would benefit the discussion section

Furthermore, the limitations of the study could be outlined, as well as suggestions for future research.
