The research paper is well structured, using various references, translating the ideas and brining it to non native speakers. However, some of the ideas are not clear, concise and argumentative. The paper doesn't contain the main basics of writing which are: a literature review and problem statement. So there is no research without problem statement, and no problem statement without a literature review, The author has repeated the classical ideas on the topic without benefiting from the contemporary Islamic scholars' discussions and their point of views in order to come up with sound result. The paper contained technically some errors in writing such us no transliteration provided, some words are not translated or not meaningful in their context, no references or wrong references pages sometimes and no references of translations of classical paragraphs.

I suggest to revise the paper, edit it by an expert and republish it.

The paper deserves to be published due to its importance, and I urge the author to do the necessary amendments if its under his possibility.
