1.The article's research methodology and data sources are clear, but there are some issues with the structure and logic of the article that need further improvement.

2.The following addition to the abstract is recommended:

(1). Background and motivation of the article's study, i.e., why it is important to analyze the use of emerging technologies for online learning among Moroccan nursing students.

(2). The innovation and contribution of your article, i.e., how your article is different and superior relative to the existing literature.

3.It is recommended that you add the following to the introduction section: a contextualization of the emerging technologies in nursing education and online learning in Morocco, a description of the real need and importance of the study.

4.The discussion section of the article should provide specific recommendations and policy implications to enhance the value and usefulness of the research.

5.The article study did not categorize and analyze the types and characteristics of emerging technologies, which could be considered to more accurately understand the impact of different types and characteristics of emerging technologies on learning processes and outcomes.

6.The article study did not consider important indicators of learning outcomes such as nursing students' academic performance, satisfaction, and self-efficacy, and only used the number of emerging technologies used as the dependent variable, which may not adequately reflect the quality and effectiveness of online learning.
