

Review of: "Human Rights Aspects in Infrastructure Projects in the President Regulation Number 120 Year 2022"

The study discusses the Presidential Regulation of the Republic of Indonesia Number 120 Year 2022 concerning Special Assignments for Expediting Infrastructure Development. Despite the interesting topic, the study does not satisfy the requirements and structure needed for a scientific article and should be improved in many respects:

- (1) In general, the study should contain at least a title, abstract and keywords, introduction, methodology, results, and a conclusion. The study presents only a short abstract, introduction, and a limited set of results.
- (2) The abstract should be better structured, containing a premise, a clear objective, the methodology used, and the results. It should also include keywords that characterize the study.
- (3) The introduction should be better structured, including an introduction to the topic with the state of the art, objective, possible contributions of the study, and the structure of the paper itself.
- (4) Include a clear section on the methodology used.
- (5) The results should be more developed, currently being limited to one or two sentences per theme.
- (6) Include a clear section on the conclusions of the study, which should present the objectives achieved, a discussion of the topic, eventual theoretical and practical contributions, limitations, and suggestions for future work.
- (7) In some sentences, expressions such as "the researcher" have been used. The text should be impersonal, avoiding similar expressions.
