The paper is more a technical report than a scientific paper. The difference is in the purpose: a technical report describe a technical project and experience, a scientific paper presents the relations and the contributions given to the literature by the presented experience/case study. A related work section is missing, and even a statement of the contribution of the paper to the literature. A better presentation could be: Introduction, related works, description of the problem, description of the solution, description of the implementation, description and discussion of the performed experiments, threats to validity, conclusions.

More details are needed in the description of implementation and experiments. Furthermore, I suggest a cost-benefit analysis. Is this approach low-cost? I think it should be a point to highlight.

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
