The work provides a good information on Buruli ulcer in the Jasikan Municipality. Overall it is well written but will benefit from brevity as some information could be summarised. In particular, some information on study site might not be necessary if it has already been published/reported in previous studies conducted in Jasikan municipality unless it's the first ever report. Under study population, the population of Jasikan municipality, and the number of houses could be stated to help appreciate the use of census approach and subsequently the prevalence calculations.

To help appreciate classification or diagnosis can the questionnaire employ be added as supplementary information for reproducibility. Perhaps a brief summary of the confirmation test at Noguchi.

The results is generally well presented in Tables and easy to understand. Including a column for p values to determine whether there is a correlation between the variables age, gender etc and Buruli ulcer would add width to the results and enrich the discussions.

Discussion could also be enriched by comparing the findings of the study to the national picture.
