3rd paragraph: 1st sentence, remove "and many cases of HIV occur in people with HBV". Third and fourth sentences are contradictory in relation to therapy of HIV.

4th paragraph: the first 2 sentences have been discussed in the previous paragraph. The last sentence can be the beginning of the next paragraph.
