**Recommendation:** The author should provide a clear and concise explanation of the research methodology, ensuring transparency and reproducibility of the study.

**Poor Grammar and Writing Style:** The article suffers from numerous grammatical errors, awkward sentence structures, and inconsistent writing style. These issues distract readers from focusing on the content.

Recommendation: The author should carefully proofread the article for grammar and style errors to enhance the overall clarity and coherence of the writing.

Conclusion:

The lack of clarity, inadequate literature review, insufficient methodological detail, and poor grammar and writing style undermine the article's credibility and impact. Addressing these issues through revisions will greatly enhance the article's scientific rigor and contribute to understanding Buruli ulcer.
