There is no detailed information about the required coding, how to assemble the device or the followed parameters to collect the data from the costumers or tested and how did they ensure no biases during that process. Contextual images are too big and relevant images such as the workflow diagram is too compact so it can be challenging to read and comprehend. I hope the document is further extended providing data and details about the analyses performed.
