- 1. In Table 1. Cattle fattening cost (BDT/cattle) estimation, labor cost was in the fixed cost items; however, labor cost is generally the variable cost as far as estimation for the enterprise budget goes.
- 2. Regarding the estimation of the marketing cost of slaughtered cattle by the meat seller, is there nothing about labor cost?

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
