My comments on the manuscript entitled "Coronavirus COVID-19: A Short Review on the Psychological Effects of Coronavirus, How It Disturbs Social Life, Its Mechanism to Affect the Central Nervous System, Possible Modes of Transmission, and the Smart Lockdown Policy of Pakistan" are as follows.

1. The abstract section should also include limitations of the manuscript (questions left unanswered) along with future prospects.
2. The manuscript writing is very superficial. The manuscript should be checked by a native English speaker before submission.
3. The last paragraph of the intro section should be more focused on your major objectives and approaches utilized in the study of your manuscript. Novelty should be included in this section with appropriate justification.
4. Write a discussion section of about 1000 words just before the conclusion section and relate all your major findings with your outcomes in this section.
5. Limitations and future prospects of your manuscript should be given in your conclusion section.
6. The overall writing and presentation are sloppy with major grammatical errors, and substantial revision is needed to improve the manuscript. Further clarification is required in some areas.
7. Include a signalling image as per the major content and findings of your manuscript.
8. Include 2 relevant bibliographic studies like PMID: 36092161 and PMID: 33091590 in your manuscript..
9. A lot of grammatical and punctuation mistakes are found in your whole manuscript.
10. Complete editorial checking will be needed for the whole manuscript.
12. Include one additional table regarding recent advancements as per the major content of your manuscript.

13. Submit an English editing certificate along with a plagiarism checker with your manuscript.
14. A review manuscript is not merely a collection and citation of literature. Authors' own input should be given at the end of each paragraph.
