Title: The word weathering, which has been used here to refer to groups withstanding weather changes can be confused with the physical breakdown of rocks. Title can still stand without the words 'Weathering changes'.

Figures 1 and 2 speak of rural districts, what are these districts? And how were they identified?

The authors speak about 'households' were they visited? or it all depended on the panel data.

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
