- 2-) Be careful about punctuation, as in the following sentence, which should not be used.

An experimental design, based on switching attention deficit and functional magnetic resonance imaging, is proposed.

- 3-) You can mention environmental factors that may trigger symptoms of schizophrenia, such as air pollution.
- 4-) You can also mention that smoking is very common in patients with schizophrenia and that smoking can also impact the severity of schizophrenia symptoms (Uludag&Zhao, 2023). Paper name: Narrative review on the association between smoking and schizophrenia symptoms.
- 5-) You can improve the following sentences. It seems they are not very relevant.
