The article is an interesting take on corruption in the medical profession and healthcare. However, there are some major observations:

- 1. The title should reflect the objective of the study.
- 2. Introduction and review need to be concise, crisp, and more scientifically written.
- 3. The objectives of the study should be rewritten clearly.
- 4. Methodology is not very elaborate. Sample size calculations, including assumptions used, and sample collection, are not explained appropriately.
- 5. How 185 medical and media persons represented the viewpoint of Nigerians is not understandable.
- 6. The article mentions that it studies corruption since 1960. However, it is just a cross-sectional study of some medical and media persons.
- 7. Conclusions should clearly mention the take-home message(s).
