The article is an interesting take on corruption in the medical profession and healthcare. However, there are some major observations:

1. The title should reflect the objective of the study.
2. Introduction and review need to be concise, crisp, and more scientifically written.
3. The objectives of the study should be rewritten clearly.
4. Methodology is not very elaborate. Sample size calculations, including assumptions used, and sample collection, are not explained appropriately.
5. How 185 medical and media persons represented the viewpoint of Nigerians is not understandable.
6. The article mentions that it studies corruption since 1960. However, it is just a cross-sectional study of some medical and media persons.
7. Conclusions should clearly mention the take-home message(s).
