This study is a great first step in investigating mediumship for pets, which parallels human mediumship and shows the potential for stringent methods.

While the methodological strengths are remarkable, the small sample size and statistical power highlight the need for additional research. Future research should benefit from a larger, more diverse participant pool as well as established controls to address the subjectivity of sitter judgments. Overall, this paper provides a good foundation for future research in this unexplored area.
