The topic is very interesting and as it is a type of entrepreneurship that is linked to the Sustainable Development Goals agenda, it is noticeably contemporary.

The theoretical support seems appropriate to me, but I would suggest that special attention be given to the citation and referencing process since it presents several areas for improvement in accordance with APA Standards. On the other hand, the structure and writing must be considered according to the space where you want to share the article, so it would be important to respect the publication policy (there you will be told if you will use numbers instead of authors and the order of your references).

I agree with the observation that, before mentioning any acronym, the full name should be mentioned if it is the first time it is introduced in the text.

Two sampling groups are mentioned in the abstract, but this explanation is not supported or explained later in the methodology. On the other hand, the article provides a contribution to the Hockerts model, but does not result in the model previously developed by the same author; it would be important to change this detail in the writing.

The structure of the article gives evidence of a well-founded investigation, however, the methodological aspect must be further explored.

In that sense, it is necessary to determine the population (whether it is Bangladesh or Tunisia or both), indicate the eligibility criteria of the sample (to know where the participants come from) and add here the explanation about the sampling groups that provides clarity on why the numbers differ between the abstract and the analysis presented.

The discussion and conclusion can be expanded by emphasizing the need for the study to include the perception of financial security in the Hockerts model.
